Ak-Chin Indian Community Request for Proposal for Carnival Midway Buyout Services for Masik Tas Celebration

The Ak-Chin Indian Community (“Community”) has an annual event known as “Masik Tas” (Birthday) Celebration during the first part of December. There are a number of activities that are a part of the annual event from a rodeo, parade, concerts, and carnival which draws thousands of spectators to the Community. These activities take place at Ak-Chin Circle and other designated areas throughout the Community. The Community will go into a contract for Carnival Midway Services for a multi-term of three (3) years. The dates of the Celebration this year are Thursday, December 14th through Sunday, December 17th, 2023. This RFP is for one (1) year with the option to extend and lock in for two (2) additional years making it a three (3) year partnership.

The Community is located 35 miles south of Phoenix in the northwestern part of Pinal County. The City of Maricopa is a neighbor to the Community. Masik Tas carnival will take place at Ak-Chin Circle located off of Narcia Road and Ak-Chin Parkway behind Ak-Chin Multi-tainment Center next to Harrah’s Ak-Chin Casino Resort.
