## ORDER OF THE CHAIRMAN of the Ak-Chin Indian Community

(Rescinding the Order directing closure of the Ak-Chin Indian Community Parks and Recreational Facilities.)

---

**WHEREAS,** on March 26, 2020, the Ak-Chin Indian Community Council (“Community Council”) issued a declaration entitled “Declaration of the Ak-Chin Indian Community Proclaiming a State of Emergency Due to the COVID-19 Outbreak” (“Declaration”); and

**WHEREAS,** the Declaration authorizes the Chairman, or the Chairman’s designee, to act on behalf of the Community and to take (or direct the taking of) any and all actions necessary to carry out the intent of the Declaration, including, but not limited to, security and law enforcement actions and issuing communications of general health and safety information to the public; and

**WHEREAS,** I issued an Order (“Order”) directing closure of the Ak-Chin Indian Community Parks and Recreational Facilities effective on April 8, 2020, and that Order was subsequently amended to remain in effect until rescinded; and

**WHEREAS,** since the Order was enacted, significant progress has been made in administering COVID tests and vaccination availability is not scarce within the Community; and

**WHEREAS,** the Community’s Incident Management Team (IMT) has given the opinion that it is in the best interest of the Community’s health to open the parks and recreational areas, including the pool, because COVID is less likely to be transmitted outdoors and opening these facilities will promote participation in outdoor activities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I,** Robert Miguel, Chairman of the Ak-Chin Indian Community, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Declaration of the Ak-Chin Indian Community Proclaiming a State of Emergency Due to the COVID-19 Outbreak and after consultation with the Community Council, do hereby order that the Order directing closure of the Ak-Chin Indian Community Parks and

Recreational Facilities effective on April 8, 2020, which was subsequently amended to remain in effect until rescinded, is rescinded.
